The Virginia State Board of the Ancient Order of the Hibernians

Sponsor: Bobby Mahoney, Immigration Chairman, Frank Herbert and Pat Cady Division, Alexandria, Va.

Topic: Reaffirming that each division of the AOH appoint a Chairman of Immigration who duties it will be to work with the Immigration Chair appointed by the National Board.

A.O.H. Virginia State Board,

Whereas the Preamble in our AOH National Constitution, Item 7 states that a main purpose of our organization is:

To encourage an equitable U.S. immigration law for Ireland, and to cooperate with groups for a fair American Immigration Policy,

Whereas noting with satisfaction the current efforts of the National Immigration Chairman, Dan Dennehy, working to secure a legal path for Irelands' undocumented and secure future flow for Irish immigrants

Whereas the fact that Comprehensive Immigration Reform is now possible and Irish people will have a real opportunity from current legislation to create a new life for themselves in our great Nation and to continue to contribute to the important bonds between Ireland and the US,

- 1. Encourages all Virginia AOH Divisions to cooperate with other organizations at the grassroots level to support the cause of equitable immigration reform;
