 weekend);
- New sweat socks;
- Monetary support a significant number of Veterans currently have no meaningful source of
 income or families to support them. Stipends are provided to those in need by the Hospital to
 allow the residents to buy sundry items as well as to get a haircut for instance; checks should be
 made out to "Martinsburg Veterans Medical Facility".
- Handmade cards of support this is a wonderful way for your children/grandchildren to express their "thanks for your service".....I cannot tell you how often over the years it has been the cards that deeply touched the Veteran!
